The Lower Chanceford Township Planning Commission met August 28,2023 at the township building. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM by Chairman Wiley. Members present were Dennis Miller, Suzanne Snyder and James Knight. Solicitor Malone was present also. The minutes were read and approved. We discussed the following business.

- 1. We looked at the preliminary sub-division plan for Maple Springs Farm Partnership on Frosty Hill Rd. If mortgaged a merger agreement is necessary. Lot 1A, no building allowed, Lot 4 has 2 dwelling rights, combined total acreage 62.65. Location of house and perk and probe must be shown.
- 2. Dollar General has received HOP from PennDot. The Stokes sub-division plan looks ok. Motion to approve plan made by Mr. Knight, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Miller, motion carried. Recommended to Supervisors to approve waiver by Mr. Knight, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Miller motion carried. Storm water mgt agreement not necessary, owner is responsible for stormwater facility. NPDS is last obstacle, it may take awhile.
- 3. Daniel Stoltzfus, Sinclair Rd regarding parcel CP5 wants to sub-divide. He has no building rights left, he cannot transfer a right.
- 4. Sunnyburn Produce auction expansion is 120 by 80 ft. New lease area is 3 acres total. They need DEP and NPDS approval. They will be responsible for maintaining sewage facilities. Land Development Plan is ok.
- 5. Ben Petersheim presented sketch plan, he has to meet 15 ft setback.and needs a building permit for property on Atkins Rd.
- 6. Ronald Miller hearing regarding camp ground, he has eliminated RV sites and no store. Our recommendation to zoning hearing board, 4 cabins, 10 camp sites, woodshed, relief from hydraulic test and the board discuss legal issue of having EMS in the house, motion by Mr. Miller,2<sup>nd</sup> by Ms. Snyder, motion carried.
