

AN ORDINANCE TO CONTROL PARKING ON STREET AND ROAD RIGHTS-OF-WAY WITHIN LOWER CHANCEFORD TOWNSHIP, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO BE KNOWN AS THE "LOWER CHANCEFORD TOWNSHIP PARKING ORDINANCE".

ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Lower Chanceford Township, York County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be a violation of this ordinance for any person to park any motor vehicle or for any person, partnership, corporation or association to permit any motor vehicle owned by him to be parked on a road or street right-of-way in Lower Chanceford Township unless there is in addition to the area taken by the parked motor vehicle at least fifteen (15) feet of travelable surface of street or highway between the portion of such motor vehicle most proximate to the center of the street or highway and the center of such street or highway.

Section 2. In the event a motor vehicle is parked on a street or highway right-of-way in violation of Section 1 of this ordinance, the Township Board of Supervisors shall have the right to cause the removal of such motor vehicle to a place designated by the Township and prior to the owner of such motor vehicle regaining possession of such vehicle such owner shall pay to the Township the cost incurred by the Township in causing such removal and storage, and in addition thereto pay to the Township the penalty prescribed by this ordinance.

Section 3. Lower Chanceford Township, its employees and contractors shall have no liability for any damage to any motor vehicle parked in violation of this ordinance occurring to such motor vehicle by reason of Township's removal of such vehicle from its parking location and/or by reason of the Township's road maintenance and/or snow removal equipment colliding with such motor vehicle.

Section 4. Any person, corporation, partnership, or association found in violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof by a District Magistrate, be sentenced to pay a penalty in the amount of Six Hundred (\$600.00) Dollars. Each and every day that parking continues in violation of any provision of this ordinance shall constitute a separate and distinct offense and shall be subject to separate and distinct penalties hereunder.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be known as the "Lower Chanceford Township Parking Ordinance."
