

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SPEED OF VEHICULAR TRAVEL ON CERTAIN TOWNSHIP ROADS AND ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Lower Chanceford Township, York County, Pennsylvania as follows:

I. This ordinance shall be known as the "Lower Chanceford Township Speed Limit Ordinance".

II. Because of dangerous curves and other dangerous conditions existing on certain Township roads, the Township determines that fifty-five (55) miles per hour represents an unsafe speed on such Township roads and maximum speed limits are hereby established as follows:

The maximum speed limit on McKinley Road (T-590) is hereby established at thirty-five (35) miles per hour.

III. Any person found operating a motor vehicle in violation of any provision of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof by a district magistrate, be sentenced to pay a fine in the amount of thirty-five (\$35.00) dollars. Any person exceeding the maximum speed limit by more than five (5) miles per hour shall pay an additional fine of two (\$2.00) dollars per mile for each mile in excess of five (5) miles per hour over the maximum speed limit.
